CMMC is now a contract gate. Under 32 CFR Part 170 and DFARS 252.204-7021, contracting officers will not award work unless you hold a passing CMMC status. That means 110 requirements across 14 domains, a maintained SSP and POA&M, a hard 180-day closeout clock, subcontractor flow-down, and annual affirmations, typically wrangled across spreadsheets and disconnected tools.

Built for the Regulatory Horizon

CMMC Phase 2 (November 2026) makes third-party C3PAO Level 2 certification the default for CUI contracts. Proposed FAR rules would extend NIST 800-171 safeguarding and 72-hour incident reporting to all federal contractors, and NIST 800-171 Rev 3 is on the horizon. Evidence collected once in RegScale carries across CMMC today and these mandates as they finalize.
